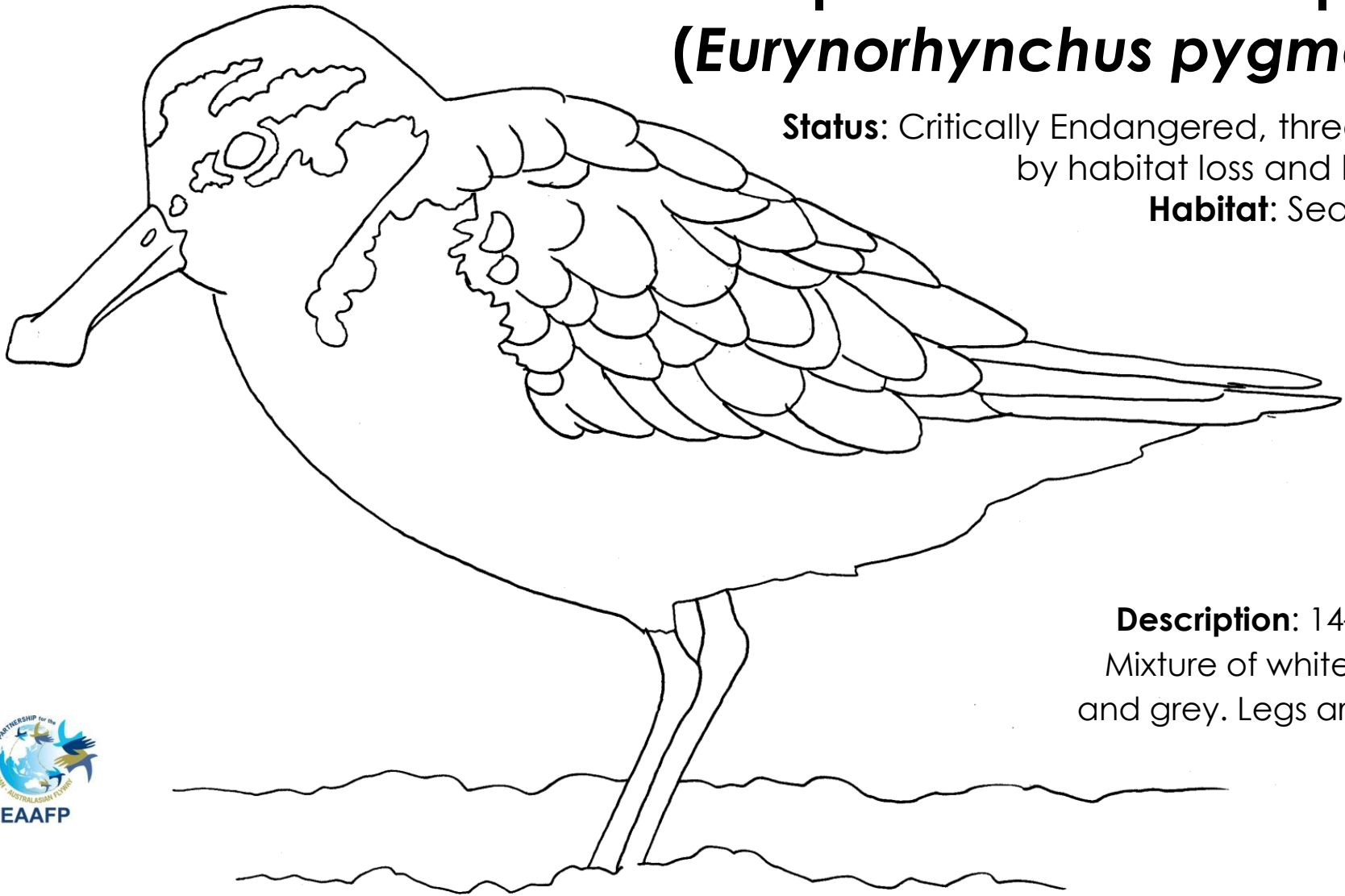


Spoon-billed Sandpiper (*Eurynorhynchus pygmeus*)

Status: Critically Endangered, threatened
by habitat loss and hunting

Habitat: Sea coasts



Description: 14–16 cm.
Mixture of white, black,
and grey. Legs are black



Non-breeding: Mostly grey on the back with a lightly streaked cap. Its underparts, throat and forehead are white, often with a white streak over the eye

Breeding: Reddish brown, particularly around the head, breast and back. The breast has varying amounts of dark spotting extending toward the belly, which is white
