The Secretariat could play a greater role in support mobilising resources for implementation of priorities of the Partnership for tasks to be undertaken by Partners (particularly NGO partners), particularly since the appointment of a resource development officer. b. The activity budget of the secretariat as well as their staff time input can be used as seed fund or co-funding to leverage larger budgets through projects. c. Secretariat staff can represent partners in project-development or other meetings.

Q12 5. Do you have any recommendations on the support needed from other Partners, Working Groups or Task Forces?

We recognise that good quality and up-to-date information on the estimates and trends of waterbird populations is crucial to monitoring and evaluating effectiveness of the Partnership, designation and monitoring of network sites, prioritising threatened species and populations and develop conservation actions. We have proposed that the Partnership institute a "Conservation Status Review" process that enables collation of the latest information on a regular basis. We would like to work closely with Partners, Working Groups and Task Forces in securing the resources needed to implement this work collaboratively.

Q13 6. Do you have any other general comments on implementation of the Partnership?

We believe there is great potential for more flyway scale projects aimed at the restoration and management of habitats and conservation of species, including on the Yellow Sea coasts. One example is of applying the landscape approach in climate change adaptation to management of critically important wetlands across the flyway. Such a project could draw lessons from the African-Eurasian Climate Resilient Flyways project funded by IKI. The Secretariat could be one of the proponents, together with Partners like Wetlands International, interested governments and others.
