About World Migratory Bird Day 2021

WMBD is an annual awareness-raising campaign highlighting the need for the conservation of migratory birds and their habitats. It has a global outreach and is an effective tool to help raise global awareness of the threats faced by migratory birds, their ecological importance, and the need for international cooperation to conserve them. In 2018, WMBD unified the planet's major migratory bird corridors, or flyways: the African-Eurasian flyway, the East Asian-Australasian flyway, and the Americas flyways. **WMBD is now celebrated twice a year, on the Second Saturday in May and in October. In 2021, WMBD will be held on 8 May and 9 October.** The EAAFP Secretariat encourages Partners to celebrate WMBD twice a year.

Introduction of EAAFP WMBD 2021 Small Grant

The Small Grant for 2021 [World Migratory Bird Day](#) (WMBD) has been established to provide financial support to [EAAFP Partners](#) and [EAAFP Task Forces and Working Groups](#) who plan to organize **public events and/or conservation action-oriented workshops** at national or local levels through participating in the World Migratory Bird Day. We strongly encourage EAAFP Partners and collaborators to make an application for any suitable event or development of WMBD materials in local language that aims to raise awareness on the need of conserving migratory waterbirds and the value of their habitats in East Asian – Australasian Flyway.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants who plan to organize an event to celebrate World Migratory Bird Day 2021 need to base in the EAAFP Partner countries. In addition, EAAFP Partner countries included in the DAC list of ODA Recipients are our priority to support. (If you are not sure, please see the [list of EAAFP Partners](#), and [DAC list of ODA Recipients](#)). If you are not the country focal point of EAAFP, please consult and plan with EAAFP focal point of your country before you apply.

Please note that this grant is to initiate a WMBD event, not to cover the costs for the existing WMBD event expenses. Applications with similar contents (location, target participants etc.) to previous years may not be accepted.

*Due to COVID-19, we encouraged applicants to carry out activities which prevent face-to-face activities to reduce risk of spreading COVID-19. All activities organization has to follow national guidelines of the country to prevent COVID-19. We also encourage proposals to promote Flyway Network Sites for the WMBD activities.

Information of the application

Firstly, Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria set for funding assistance under EAAFP WMBD 2021 Small Grants Programme.

For your budget planning, please note a maximum of 1,000 USD will be allocated to each country. We recommend you submit the application as early as possible.

The deadline for application is **20 August 2021**. Please submit an application to Ms. Vivian Fu, Communication Officer via email (Word or PDF document) at communication@eaaflyway.net and wmbd@eaaflyway.net.

After the Secretariat receives your application, the approval of successful proposals is made by the Secretariat. Applicant will hear of the result within two weeks after the deadline. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Successful applicants have a responsibility to help translate the World Migratory Bird Day materials into their own languages which will be shared on the World Migratory Bird Day website (<https://www.worldmigratorybirdday.org/>).

From this activity, we expect it can motivate people to give concern about world bird migration especially in indonesia, either through bird watching or various event related to conservation activities for migratory birds or even it can educated young student about bird migration activity in indonesia.

Other purpose :

1. To know the impacts of pandemic to bird migration activity
2. To observe migratory bird and its habitat in nature
3. To educate citizens and students about migratory bird's habitat conservation
4. To increase people awareness for habitat conservation and the activity of migratory bird in pandemic
5. To educate young children about migratory bird and introducing it to them.

1. Counseling, Migrasi Burung di Tengah Pandemi (30 September & 1 October 2021)

The first day of Counseling will be held in Universitas Sumatera Utara on 30 September. The goal of this counseling is to give knowledge about migratory bird species and birdwatching technique for the citizens and college students. We also inviting them to join the birdwatching trip, so they can learn a lot more about the migratory bird.

The second Counseling will be held in the Nearest school from the Coast of Bagan Serdang on 1 October 2021. The goal of this counseling is to give knowledge about migratory bird and it's migratory activity. We're also a drawing contest for the children on the school with bird migration theme to increase the interest of the children about migratory bird conservation. We are also giving a WMBD themed T-shirt to each of the participants for them to use throughout the event.

2. Field Trip, Birdwatching (2 October 2021)

The Birdwatching trip will be held on the Coast of Bagan Serdang Village. This activity is a direct effort to invite the public to see first hand the conditions of the habitat and migratory birds in North Sumatera, Indonesia. The participants will also given the opportunity to learn how to identify the migratory bird on person and learn Birdwatching technique. This activity will take place by implementing health protocols and limiting the number of participants.

The outcome of the event are :

1. The children are more aware for the cleanliness of the beach near the migratory bird sites.
2. The participants got more knowledge about migratory bird, its migratory behaviour, and how to identify them.
3. From the field trip, childrens and participants got new skill of how to do birdwatching, and recognizing what is the tool to do birdwatching.

We are getting a lot of problem along the way because of the Covid 19 Pandemic. But, with the help of EAAFP Secretariat that gave us guidance, we can carry out our event.

Section 2. EVENT PROGRAMME (Compulsory)

The World Migratory Bird Day event from us run in 3 days.

1. Counseling in Universitas Sumatera Utara (30th September 2021)
The Counseling take place in Universitas Sumatera Utara on 30th September 2021, 14:00 WIB. The speaker give learning material about migratory bird (definition, species, identification). From this event, we give the participants certificate for attending the counseling, and also giving T-shirt for the participants that join us on the field trip.
2. Counseling in Nearest School in Bagan Serdang (31st September 2021)
The Counseling take place in SDN 106448 Bagan Serdang, Pantai Labu Region, Deli Serdang on 31st September 2021, 08:00 WIB. We share the information of World Migratory Bird Day to the children on school, and also give the children of what the impact of plastic waste on migratory bird activity and how it harm the shore bird. We're giving T-shirt to the childrens that join the field trip.
3. Field Trip in Bagan Serdang Coast
The field trip take place on Bagan Serdang Coast on 1st October 2021, 10:00 WIB. The participants have the opportunity to watch the bird in person on its habitat. The field guide also give them the lesson to identify the shore bird live on its habitat. The participant also learned on how to use a binocular and monocular to do birdwatching.

- Fuel for 2 car for 2 days : Budget spent for transportation fuel for 2 days.
- Survey Team : We organize a survey team for communicating with the school and in person. The budget spent for fuel and consumption for the survey team.

3. Logistics

- Rent Monocular and Binocular : Budget spent for renting monocular and binocular for participants to use in the Field Trip.
- Drawing equipment : Budget spent to buy drawing equipments. This drawing equipments including drawing pencils, sketch paper, and sharpener.
- Face Mask & Hand Sanitizer : Budget spent to buy 3 boxes of face mask and 4 bottle of hand sanitizer. We are implementing safety protocol to avoid the spreading of Covid-19.
- T-shirt : Budget spent to design and create 36 T-shirts. The purpose of this T-shirt is to raise the people's interest to celebrate World Migratory Bird Day, and give more concern to migratory bird conservation.
- Banner, Charter, and Stamp : Budget spent to design and create two banners, one charter, and one stamp to use during the events.
- Tripod : Budget spent to buy a Tripod which we use in the field trip.

4. Field Guide : Budget spent to pay the service of one field guide. The field guide will accompany us during the field trip on the third day.

5. Speaker Honorium : Budget spent to pay the service of one speaker on our counseling event. The speaker will give the participants the field material to use for the field trip, and also bird identification technique.

6. Video Editor : Budget spent to pay the service of a Video Editor, this video will became a campaign on Indonesia society to join the next WMBD event that EAAFP are offering.

Section 4. SHORT SUMMARY REPORT (Compulsory)

The World Migratory Bird Day is a celebration for all of conservation activist working on nature biodiversity across the world. In Indonesia, migratory bird conservation activity is so low. In fact, civilian doesn't give attention at all for the migratory bird. This is the problem that we are facing right now in our country. Also, COVID-19 became a new burden to us to face, the government has made a regulation to avoid crowd and giving no travel access to unvaccinated person. But, with the help of our university, all of us got vaccinated in time.


The event start on September 30th. The first day of our event take place in University of Sumatera Utara. We are holding a counseling event with the student and civilian that registrated to attend the event. There are 30 participants that attend the counseling event. The outcomes are the participants will have birdwatching and identification technique which will be used in the field trip.

The second day of our event start on October 1st. We are holding a counseling on a school near the field trip site. The participants are the student that attend the school, there are 45 students in total. The outcomes from this event are the students get new education about migratory bird and also the cleanliness of the beach from plastic wastes which will impacted the migratory birds. The students are very welcome and excited about this counseling event.

The last day of our event start on October 2nd. The field trip take place on Bagan Serdang Beach. There are 15 participants on this event, 10 students from the school and 5 others are selected participants from counseling on the first day. Field trip run smoothly and all the participants are experiencing birdwatching live.

From all of our event, we are hoping that it will impact the Indonesia society to became more aware of migratory bird from now on. Also, the children in Indonesia are the main target for us to be educated because we believe the next generation will have the power to change the world in the future.
