World Migratory Bird Day (WMBD) 2023 has the theme Water: Sustaining Bird Life, with that theme, we want this celebration to be carried out with children with disabilities in Banda Aceh City using experienced methods and teachers to introduce migratory birds to children. children with disabilities under the auspices of Special Schools (Indonesia: Sekolah Luar Biasa (SLB).

The perception of the people of Banda Aceh City has so far been formed towards persons with disabilities that they are a minority group so it is only natural that persons with disabilities rarely appear in the public sphere along with others. Differences in views between society today that lead to unsupportive behavior from society for the involvement of persons with disabilities.

Research Center for Elephant Conservation and Biodiversity Forest (Indonesia: Pusat Riset Konservasi Gajah dan Biodiversitas Hutan) will be the main executor of the activity by presenting speakers from Muhammadiyah University of Banda Aceh, Mrs. Maria Ulva, S.Psi., M.Pd with a background in Psychology, so that it has a special teaching method for students to introduce and celebrate World Migratory Bird Day (WMBD) 2023.

The activities to be carried out are as follows:

1. WMBD 2023 Seminar with the theme "Water: Sustaining Bird Life"
The seminar will be filled by speakers from the Muhammadiyah University of Banda Aceh, Mrs. Maria Ulva, S.Psi., M.Pd with a psychology background. The main target of this activity is students with disabilities in Special Schools (SLB) in Banda Aceh City, Aceh Province. The second speaker is Dr. Abdullah, M.Si, who will provide materials to school teachers in implementing inclusive learning methods.
2. Application of Inclusive Education Methods with Migratory Bird Conservation Materials
This inclusive education method opens up opportunities for all students without exception, and makes it easier for students, especially children with special needs, to be involved in education together with other children and to access education that is followed close to the environment where the child lives.
3. Migratory Bird Festival
The celebration will be filled with giving souvenirs and learning aids to students and their parents as an effort to support them in obtaining a better education,

as well as through souvenirs will get to know various important things in the field of migratory bird conservation.
